

**MINUTES OF THE EASTERN ZONE MEETING

There was not an awards ceremony for the ten and unders at the long course meet, and the general body felt there should be.  
There has to be warm up times for the different LSC's for the summer meet sent out before the meet begins. This should be posted on the web site.

**Sectionals**

Region 1 – The only individual event time change was the women's 400 IM. The relays have cuts, and as long as a relay makes the cut times, an individual swimmer can be a relay only swimmer. The summer Sectional Meet will be Aug. 1-4, 2002 at Erie Community College in Buffalo., hosted by STAR Swimming. A motion was made, seconded and passed to allow the following: A fax entry, to be received by 6:00 p.m. Monday – August 5, 2002, to allow a new swimmer or a new event for a previously entered swimmer, from the Sectional Meet only, to enter the Zone Meet. They would be seeded into the open events. This is for the Region 1 Sectional Meet only. Meet dates for 2003 are: March 6-9, 2003, and July 31- August 3, 2003. Site to be determined.

Region 2 – Long Course Zone Meet will be held July 26-29, 2002 at George Mason University. In Fairfax, Virginia. It will be hosted by Curl Burke.

\*\*\*Joann Faucett – the Zone Officials chair said to get all the information to her as soon as possible. Who the meet director will be. She needs the information to post the meet on the website for officials to sign up to help.

Athlete's Report – Justin Lynch said there were not enough swimmers at convention to have a report. He feels the Sectional meets are too split up and are not the same as Juniors. Also would like the names of each LSC's athlete reps.
