LOCATION	<p>The meet will be held at the McCoy Natatorium on the campus of The Pennsylvania State University, Curtin & Bigler Roads, University Park, PA 16802. (the Natatorium is on the corner of Curtin and Bigler.)</p> <p>Day of meet ONLY emergency phone # 856-580-0912</p>
FACILITY	<p>POOL: 50 meter heated outdoor 8-Lane facility. Pool depth at the starting end is 12'-6" and at the turn end is 4'-6". There is a separate indoor pool for warm-up and swim-down during the meet. Competition pool has non-turbulent lane markers and a Colorado System 5 Timing System. The competition course has been certified in accordance with USA Swimming rule 104.2.2C(4).</p> <p>PARKING: Available in parking decks near the Natatorium. Penn State University controls all parking and fees. Lots near the Bryce Jordan Center may have unrestricted parking. Please read restriction signs carefully.</p> <p>FOOD: A limited selection of food and swimming apparel will be available for spectators and swimmers throughout the meet.</p>

<p>VOLUNTEERS</p>	<p>Each LSC will be responsible to provide at least two (2) timers for EACH preliminary session. Lane assignments will be provided to the Team Manager. LSCs are encouraged to provide timers for the Finals session each night.</p>
<p>ELIGIBILITY</p>	<p>Competition is restricted to swimmers registered with one of the 12 LSCs in the Eastern Zone. Each swimmer must be a 2011 USA Swimming registered athlete in the LSC which he/she represents. On-site registration will not be accepted at this meet. Each swimmer must be entered by the LSC prior to the entry deadline. Swimmer's age as of August 10, 2011, determines their age group for the entire meet.</p> <p>Each LSC may enter all swimmers who have achieved the time standard. If an LSC does not have two (2) swimmers who have achieved the time standard in an individual event, the LSC may enter no more than two (2) swimmers in that event. These swimmers shall be entered with their actual time.</p> <p>All entry times must be the swimmer's actual time achieved in LC meter only. Converted time will not be accepted. Times must have been achieved between August 4, 2010 and August 1, 2011.</p> <p>Each swimmer may enter a total of six (6) events in the meet, exclusive of relays, and may not exceed three (3) individual events per day.</p> <p>Relays must be made up of swimmers competing in the meet in individual events. 'Relay only' swimmers are NOT allowed.</p>
<p>ATHLETE AND SPECTATOR SEATING</p>	<p>The outdoor pool at the McCoy Natatorium is surrounded by grass and does not have any shade. NLAC will be renting tents to be used by all teams at the outdoor pool. The \$5 per swimmer surcharge will cover the cost of the tent rentals.</p> <p>Parents and athletes are encouraged to bring their own chairs to the meet.</p>
<p>MAXIMUM QUALIFYING TIMES</p>	<p>Please see the table on page 13 for the maximum qualifying times for each Zone event, as well as more information on these times.</p>
<p>ENTRY LIMITATIONS</p>	<p>All entry times must be LC Meters. NT entries will not be accepted for individual events.</p> <p>Each swimmer may enter a total of six (6) events in the meet, exclusive of relays, and may not exceed three (3) individual events per day.</p> <p>Relays must be made up of swimmers competing in the meet in individual events. 'Relay only' swimmers are NOT allowed.</p> <p>Individual swimmers MUST enter through their LSC.</p>

ADAPTED SWIMMERS / SWIMMERS WITH DISABILITIES

Each LSC may bring two (2) swimmers with disabilities age 12 & under, and two (2) swimmers age 13- 18 to the meet. These adapted swimmers are in addition to the swimmers who have qualifying times for the meet events. Each LSC may select the adapted swimmers at their own discretion. With the recommendation of the LSC Team Coach or Manager, the meet staff will determine where the swimmer best fits into the meet (seeded with their peers, seeded with their peers but in shorter distances, seeded with younger swimmers, etc.) and will place them accordingly. All adapted swimmers competing in the meet will receive participation medals.

- Swimmers with disabilities may compete without having achieved the qualifying standard for their age group. However, they must provide a time for each event they enter. Swimmers with disabilities shall be entered on the form included on the next page. You can e-mail this information but, ALL of the information on the entry form must be included in the e-mail. Classification of swimmer with a disability is irrelevant.
- Each LSC may select two (2) swimmers with disabilities age 12&U and two (2) swimmers age 13-18 in any manner deemed appropriate.
- Swimmers with disabilities may compete in Finals, earn awards and score points for their team in the same manner as the able-bodied swimmers.
- It is the responsibility of the swimmer, or his / her coach, to inform the Meet Referee of any disability-related accommodations he /she may need in order to compete. In addition, this information must be given in advance of the meet on the entry form. The Meet Referee shall determine any modifications that may be required. This information shall be relayed to the starter and stroke and turn judges. Visually impaired swimmers who require tappers must bring their own devices and individuals to use them.
- Aside from the norm, the meet staff has the ability to seed the swimmer with a disability in a number of ways. These options include: seed the swimmer with others of the appropriate gender, allowing the swimmer to compete half the distance of their age group (swim the 100 meter. backstroke during the 200 meter. backstroke race), or swim with a younger age group where their entry time is similar to the able-bodied swimmers for the same distance (a 15 year old swimmer with a disability could swim the 100 meter freestyle with the 10 & U age group). The final meet result should show the swimmer with a disability listed in the correct age and event, regardless of where he / she actually competed. The Meet Referee may reassign the lane of a deaf swimmer if a required view of the strobe light is obscured, and the light can not be repositioned.
- It is the responsibility of the USA Swimming Adapted Chair to provide the Meet Referee with current American Records for swimmers with disabilities. It is the swimmer's responsibility to complete and submit an application for an American Record, should one be set.

ENTRY FEES	Individual events are \$8.00 per entry; Relays are \$10.00 per entry.
SWIMMER SURCHARGE	There is a \$5 per swimmer meet surcharge. This will cover the cost of renting tents to provide shade for the swimmers around the outdoor pool during the course of the meet.
HOW TO ENTER	<p>All entry times MUST be in LC Meters. Entries should be completed using Team Manager or other third party software capable of generating an SDIF file. Send the CL2, HY3, or SDIF file as an e-mail attachment to the Meet Director at admingpac@gmail.com. A PDF of the entry report should be sent with the e-mailed file.</p> <p>Entry checks should be made payable to Nittany Lion Aquatic Club. Mail the entry fee check and entry certification form to -</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Matthew Sprang P.O. Box 293 Sewell, NJ 08080</p> <p>Please request 'waiver of signature' if using a service that provides one.</p> <p>Individual swimmers MUST enter through their LSC. No fax or phone entries will be accepted.</p> <p>The submission of an entry by an LSC represents a contract between the entering LSC and the host LSC. Entry in this meet represents the entering LSC's intention to comply with the rules and regulations of the meet as stated.</p> <p>NO DECK ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED FOR THIS MEET.</p>
ENTRY DEADLINE	<p>All entries must be received by 7:00 PM, August 1, 2011. Fees must be received within seven (7) days of the entry deadline. No late entries will be accepted.</p>
PROOF OF TIME	<p>Each LSC is responsible for proof of time for its entry and must provide written certification with their entries, via a LSC Officer's signature, attesting to the accuracy of those entries. See final page of the meet information.</p> <p>After the meet, the Zone Championship Coordinator will conduct an audit of entry times vs. meet results; based on the results of this audit, an LSC may be required to provide proof of time for selected swims, if not already proven. Proof of time has been defined as a time included in the SWIMS database, or which can be proven by official meet results (including the cover sheet).</p> <p>Failure to prove a time will result in a fine of one hundred dollars (\$100) per swim and the LSC will be responsible for paying the fine. Failure to pay the fine will result in exclusion from future EZ Meets.</p>
START PROCEDURES	<p>With the exception of the evening's Finals session, 'fly-over' starts will be used at this meet. All swimmers (except for Backstroke starts) should remain in the water at the completion of their race until the next heat has begun.</p>

<p>SUBSTITUTIONS</p>	<p>Each LSC is entitled to substitutions only in the event that fewer than two (2) swimmers from that LSC would remain to compete in an event.</p> <p>Only swimmers already entered in the meet can be used as substitutes. The entry deadline for substitutions will be thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of each session. No adjustments in seeding will be made to accommodate the substitution.</p> <p>A form for making substitutions will be provided in the manager’s packet.</p>
<p>RELAYS</p>	<p>All relays are positive check in events and will be conducted as Timed Finals in the evening Finals sessions, with the exception of 10 & U relays which will swim as Timed Finals in the afternoon session.</p> <p>Each LSC is limited to two (2) relays per event.</p>
<p>TEAM MANAGER</p>	<p>Each LSC must provide the name of an individual to serve as the official Team Manager. An alternate may also be named. Team Managers or alternates must represent the LSC at any meeting called by the Meet Director to discuss matters concerning the meet. Only the Team Manager or alternate is permitted to represent the LSC. Protests will not be accepted from anyone other than the Team Manager or alternate.</p> <p>The Team Managers meeting will take place at the outdoor pool in the Officials’ tent on August 9th at 6:00 p.m. Team Managers or the official Alternate Team Manager from each LSC MUST be present at the meeting. All participants are responsible for information covered at this meeting!</p>
<p>WARM-UP PROCEDURES</p>	<p>Lanes for warm-ups will be assigned for each LSC. There will be no diving from the blocks unless the Meet Referee has designated that lane as a one way sprint lane.</p> <p>No paddles or ancillary equipment may be used during the official warm-up period.</p> <p>LSC’s are expected to monitor their assigned lanes to ensure a safe warm-up procedure.</p> <p>The competition pool will be available on Tuesday evening from 4-8 pm.</p> <p>The pool will open for warm-ups each morning of the meet (Wednesday through Saturday) at 6:45 am. We will announce warm-up and session start times for each session once all entries are received and we have run a preliminary timeline. This information will be emailed to all LSCs and will be posted on the Middle Atlantic Swimming and Nittany Lion Aquatic Club websites.</p> <p>Based on the number of meet entries, warm-up and start times are subject to change.</p> <p>At least one indoor pool will be available to swimmers throughout the meet.</p>

SEEDING

This is a pre-seeded meet. The fastest eight (8) swimmers at Prelims, after scratches, will advance to the Finals in Prelim / Final Events. The following events are positive check-in events - the 400/800/1500 freestyle, the 400 IM, and all relays. Any swimmer who fails to “check-in” for a positive check-in event will NOT be seeded into the event (scratched from the event). Any swimmer who “checks-in” for a positive check-in event and fails to compete in said event shall be barred from competing in his/her next individual event. The fastest heat of the Men’s 1500 Free and Women’s 800 Free will be swum with Finals. All heats of the Men’s 800 Free and Women’s 1500 Free will be swum in the Preliminary session.

Positive check-in deadlines are as follows:

All morning events by 7:30 am

All afternoon events by 12:30 pm

All Finals relays must be checked in prior to the conclusion of the afternoon Prelims.

The Meet Director/ Referee reserve the right to divide the meet into an ‘A’ and ‘B’ flight if it is warranted by the timeline based on entries.

RULES

COMPETITION: This meet will be conducted according to current USA Swimming rules. USA SWIMMING / MA SWIMMING SAFETY GUIDELINES AND WARM-UP PROCEDURES WILL BE IN EFFECT FOR THE ENTIRE MEET.

SCRATCH: The scratch procedure will be done in accordance with USA Swimming rules 207.12.6.D & E.

Scratches from Finals should be turned in on the provided form to the Admin Referee no later than 30 minutes following the announcement of the preliminary results. Please turn in scratches for Prelims and Timed Finals events to the Admin Referee prior to the start of each session. There is no penalty for missing a Prelims or Timed Finals event.

SAFETY: Only currently credentialed coaches, USA Swimming registered athletes and essential meet personnel will be permitted on deck and in the athlete area.

CONDUCT: The Eastern Zone Rules of Conduct will apply. Proper conduct at all times will be enforced by coaches, chaperones, parents, meet marshals and meet directors.

Any issues of conduct which occur within the meet venue will be adjudicated by the meet jury. Misconduct includes but is not limited to: violations of safety guidelines outlined in the meet announcement; disrespect to meet management personnel, officials or fellow athletes; stealing, destroying, vandalizing or possessing the property of others; possession or use of alcoholic

	<p>beverages, tobacco products or illegal drugs. More serious violations may result in legal action by the host LSC's and local authorities.</p> <p>ADVERSE WEATHER: In case of adverse weather, the outdoor pool will close for at least 30 minutes; all spectators and swimmers MUST leave the outdoor pool deck. Spectators are asked to wait in the stands of the indoor Natatorium; swimmers, coaches and officials should proceed to the indoor pool area.</p>																																																				
<p>SCRATCH POLICY</p>	<p>Any swimmer who does not swim a pre-seeded preliminary or timed-final event will not be penalized.</p> <p>Any swimmer who positively checks-in for a deck-seeded event and does not swim that event will be barred from their next Individual event, either on the same or next meet day.</p> <p>Any swimmer who qualifies for Finals in a Prelims/Finals event and does not swim that event at Finals will be barred from the rest of the Meet (including relays) unless the swimmer has scratched, or indicated their possible intention to scratch, within thirty (30) minutes of the announcement of the Prelims results of that event. Swimmers indicating a possible intention to scratch must confirm such intention within thirty minutes of the swimmer's last individual event at the Prelims session; a swimmer who does not confirm their intention will not be scratched and will be seeded into the event and expected to swim. Swimmers initially announced as Alternates for the Finals heats will not be so penalized.</p> <p>A swimmer may take a Declared False Start in a Preliminary or Timed Final event, including deck-seeded events. At Finals, a Declared False Start, deliberate Delay of Meet False Start or other action to non-compete will be subject to the penalty for non-competition.</p>																																																				
<p>PROTESTS</p>	<p>A Meet Jury will adjudicate any protests, including issues of conduct, which may occur in the meet venue. All protests must be in writing to the Meet Referee. Protests regarding eligibility as stated in Rule 102.11 will not be accepted from anyone other than the Team Manager or his / her designee.
