Zone Directors' Report

The mission of the Eastern Zone is to develop a unified organization designed to work in cooperation with the LSCs to support and promote the Eastern Zone Swimming Membership.

Zone Directors Council (ZDC)

The ZDC consists of the Coach, Non-Coach, and Athlete Directors of each of the four Zones. The Junior Athlete Representatives are also invited to participate. The ZDC meets regularly with USA Swimming staff to share information and provide feedback from the LSCs.

EZ Summer Competition

As indicated in the Technical Report, the Eastern Zone was able to hold the summer zone meets this year. Due to the pandemic, the Age Group Zone meet imposed a limit on the number of athletes per LSC. Eleven out of the twelve LSCs participated. The Senior Zone meet was the largest ever held in the Eastern Zone (660 athletes). The Senior Zone meet introduced a Virtual Scratch Table to help avoid any crowded areas on the deck. The meet directors and the officials did an outstanding job making these meets a success.

USA Swimming Special Legislation

In response to requirements from the US Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC), USA Swimming held a special House of Delegates (HOD) in June to approve changes to the composition of the board, committees, and the HOD. The proposal to change the composition of the HOD did not pass.

Subsequently, USA Swimming created a new task force to develop a new proposal. The new proposal https://www.usaswimming.org/docs/default-source/governance/september-24-hod-special-meeting-proposed-legislation.pdf will be voted on at a Special HOD meeting on September 25 at NOON EDT. The Eastern Zone held a Q&A Session with members of the task force on September 12. 2021 Eastern Zone Fall Business Meeting, Sept 19, 2021 Athlete's Report

Coming off 2020-21 with many unique challenges and many typical athlete representative opportunities made virtual, we are excited and look forward to working with our 2021-22 EZ LSC Athlete Reps as we begin planning for the next chapter in athlete representation in the USA Swimming Governance Structure.

Communications with EZ LSC Athlete Reps

Especially over the course of the pandemic, EZ Athlete Reps have been focused on keeping our LSC Athlete Reps engaged and communicating information pertaining to athlete rep matters, especially in the absence of in-person zone meetings and conventions. Meetings were held at least bi-monthly throughout the beginning of the 2020-21 year, discussing the status of swimming in LSCs and how we could best support them as well as collecting athlete input as we planned for EZ Championship Meets.

Zone Director's Council (ZDC) and Zone Athlete Reps Council (ZARC)

Zone Athlete Directors and Zone Junior Athlete Reps were officially included in the Zone Director's Council for the first time this year, working alongside the Zone Coach and Non-Coach Directors. ZARC worked together to find a functional role in the USA Swimming Governance structure, serving as a bridge between the grassroots and national levels of swimming especially for athletes but also the entire Zone. ZARC also collaborated heavily as a subgroup of the USA Swimming Athletes' Executive Committee (AEC) assisting in designing athlete programming and education resources, especially pertaining to legislation.

USA Swimming USOPC Compliance Legislation

Especially with the legislation pertaining to the USA Swimming HOD, more work has been done in educating athletes on the proposals and encouraging them to voice their opinions to the working groups, collaborating with ZARC and AEC to do so. Pending the current HOD Working Group proposal passing, ZARC has also been discussing plans to formalize the selection of LSC Athlete Reps as delegates for the Annual Business Meeting for future years. Regardless, Zone Reps will be looking for ways to get grassroots athletes more involved in the higher levels of governance in USA Swimming.

Eastern Zone LSC Athlete Reps Workshop

EZ Reps are planning on having a workshop for it's LSC Athlete Reps to further build and mentor on leadership skills pertaining to athlete governance. Other Zones have typically done this in the past for their LSC Athlete Reps and we would like to start doing the same. We are looking to have one potentially in the Spring of 2022.

Zone Junior Rep Athlete Elections

As the Zone Junior Athlete Rep position is a one year term, we will be conducting elections for the EZ Junior Athlete Rep for the 2021-22 year. The election will be held September 19 at 5pm EST just prior to the EZ Fall Business Meeting, results to come.

EZ DEI Chairs Committee Report - Sept., 2021

The DE&I Chairs committee continues to convene via Zoom on, a monthly basis, less during the summer months, included in attendance Zone Directors, Tim Husson, who we sincerely appreciate having in attendance. There has been an average of approximately 70% regular LSC representation in attendance, we are currently no longer at 100% DEI Chairs for the Eastern Zone LSC's (Maryland – DEI Chair stepped down, they are actively searching for a new Chair, Mid-Atlantic – Does not have a DEI Chair, no updated information at this time). New incoming DEI Chairs for Maine (Zach Mullin), New England (Jesse Ford) appointed last week, Potomac Valley (Jessica Fry), Virginia (Jahan Davis Minson). Current DE&I Chairs will be asked to work on aligning their local goals with the overall USA Swimming strategic goals that have just been communicated Thursday (9/16). Focused on aligning with the mission & strategic plan of USA Swimming.
